#### ■ We accepted five student teachers. 5人の教育実習生を受け入れました

From November 4<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>, we accepted five student teachers for approximately three weeks. All five students are currently university students in Aichi and Gifu prefectures. Four of them are graduates of Higashi Junior High School. All of them are aiming to become school teachers.

To become a school teacher, you need to study at a university, etc., obtain a teaching license, and pass a recruitment exams. To become a junior high school teacher, you need a minimum of 67 "credits", and teaching practice is one of them.

Although they require so many credits, the student teachers are working hard to make their dream of becoming a school teacher come true. When I listened to them, I realized that although there were many different reasons why they wanted to become a school teacher, each of them had a strong desire for their own future. I thought that was wonderful.

学校の先生になるためには、大学などで学んで、教員免許を取り、採用試験に合格する必要があります。大学では、授業を受けて、試験などに合格すると「単位」というものがもらえます。中学

状の先生になるためには、最低限、決められた67の「単位」が必要です。教育実習はその中の1つです。 このように多くの「単位」が必要ですが、教育実習生の皆さんは、将来学校の先生になりたいという夢を実現させるために、一生懸命頑張っています。話を聴いてみると、学校の先生になりたい と思った理由は様々ですが、それぞれが自分の将来について熱い想いをもっていらっしゃることが分かりました。素敵だなと感じました。

### ■ I observed the classes of student teachers on their teaching practice. 教育実習の先生方の授業を参観しました

During the teaching practice, students observe and learn from the lessons of the teachers they supervise, and also plan and teach their own lessons. In the third and final week, a "research lesson" was held, which was observed by many teachers. It was like a test for the teaching practice. Here is one of them.

This is a Japanese class for Grade 2 Section 5. The subject is the work "The Priest at Ninna-ji Temple" from Kenko Hoshi's "Tsurezuregusa". "Tsurezuregusa" is said to have been written in the 1300s, making it an ancient work from about 700 years ago. Although it is a story written so long ago, it contains interesting aspects of the work that are relevant to today's world, as well as the lessons the author wanted to convey. The class I visited was a class where students interpreted the work. After summarizing their thoughts individually, they engaged in free and group exchanges. Once the exchange began, the students in Grade 2 Section 5 began to share their thoughts one after the other. They were so lively. The atmosphere was very lively. I think this was because the work itself was interesting, and also because the exchange led to new discoveries, such as "I never knew there was another way to look at things". It was a lot of fun to watch. Thank you to the student teacher who planned this lesson, and to the students in Grade 2 Section 5. It was a wonderful lesson.

教育実習では、指導する先生の授業を参観して学んだり、自分で計画して授業を行ったりします。 3 週間目、最後の週には、多くの先生が参観する「研究授業」が行われました。教育実習の試験の ようなものです。そのうちの1つを紹介します。

2年5組の国語の授業です。兼好法師「徒然草」の「仁和寺にある法師」という作品が題材です。「徒然草」が書かれたのは西暦1300年代と言われていますので、今から700年くらい前の古い 作品です。そんな昔に書かれた話ではありますが、今の時代に通じる作品の面白さや作者の伝えたい教訓が含まれています。参観したのは、それを読み解く授業でした。個人で考えをまとめた後に、 自由交流や班交流をしました。交流が始まると2年5組のみなさんは、自分の考えをどんどん話し始めました。生き生きしていましたね。とても盛り上がりました。この作品自体の面白さがあり、さ らに、交流で「そんな見方があったのか」と新しい発見があったからだと思います。見ていてとても楽しかったです。こうした授業を計画してくださった教育実習の先生、2年5組のみなさん、あり がとうございました。素敵な授業でした。
