3	If the alarm is lifted between less than 2 hours before the start of classes and 10:00 a.m.	If the warning, etc. is <u>lifted</u> between after 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.	◆Classes will be held two hours after the lifting of the alert. Please do not come to school if you cannot ensure safety due to weather conditions, flooded roads, or rising rivers and waterways. In such cases, please contact the school. ◆There will be lunch as usual.
4	If the alert is <u>lifted after</u> 10:00 a.m.	If the alert is <u>lifted after</u> 9:00 a.m.	◆There will be no classes that day.
